Donate by ACH bank draft (either a one-time donation or automatic recurring donations) using the smartphone app called Give Plus. To find the app go to the APP Store or Google Play and search "give plus church." You have the option whether or not to set up an account to track your giving. Please refer to this website for additional information: GivePlus Mobile. While the website indicates that you may also donate using a credit card, our current set-up only allows donations by ACH draft. This app is affiliated with Joyful Response, the electronic giving program, that we have been using for automatic recurring drafts (see below).

Donate with a recurring ACH draft using Joyful Response. You may elect at this time to set up an ongoing weekly or monthly draft using the form that you may find on our website. Click on the "Church" tab on the bottom right of the home page and then click on "Resources" and then "Forms" in the upper right. You will see the "Joyful Response" form under "Electronic Giving" in the bottom left of your screen.
